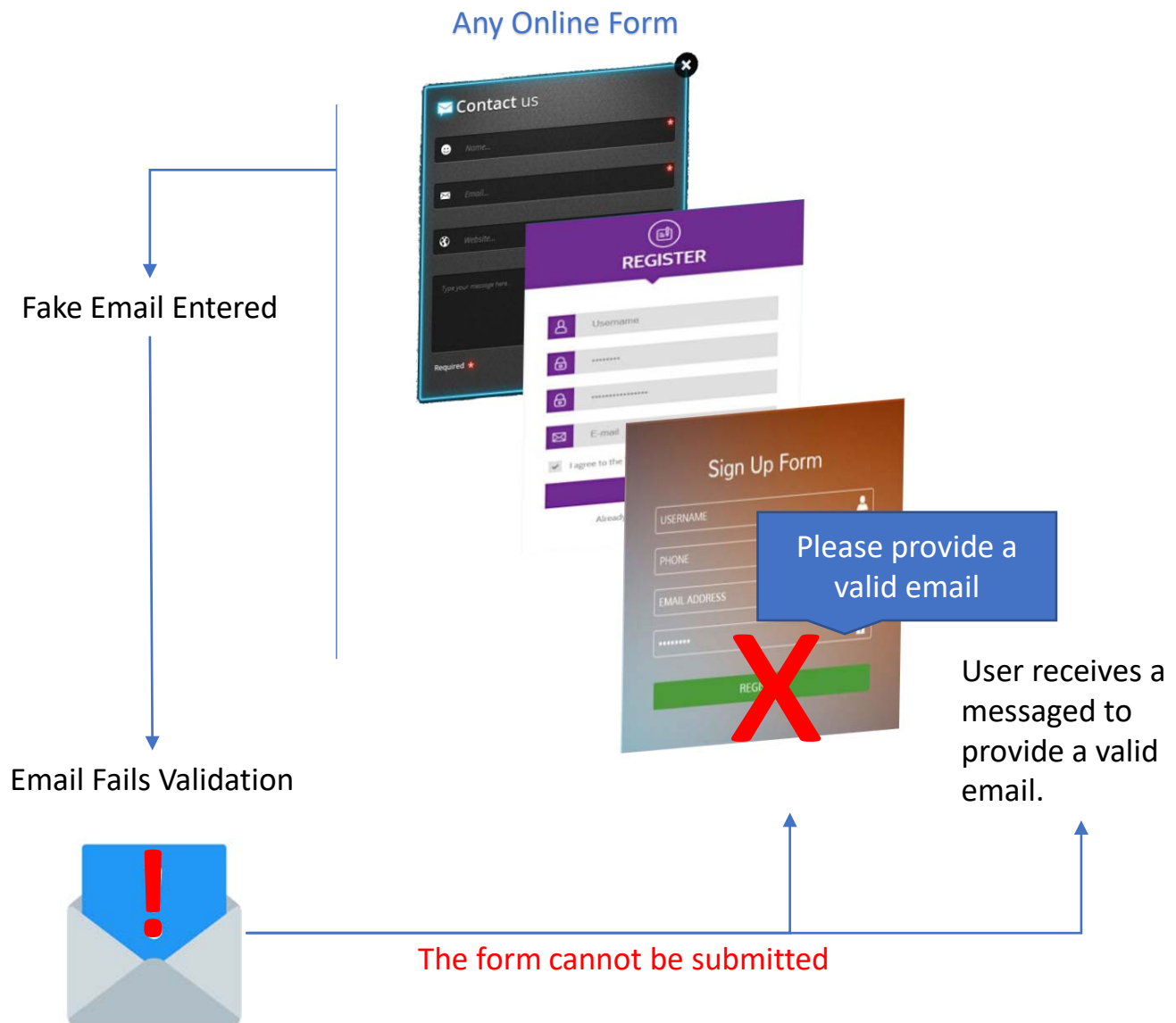

All personal and business email address can be validated. Personal domains can be blocked if required.
